Good afternoon! What a beautiful day! We are so Principal's Corner fortunate to be here in Sarasota with temperatures

in the seventies!

Tomorrow (Monday) starts the second semester and with it more preparation for statemandated testing. as well as the spring musicals. It will take the involvement of teachers, parents, and students to carry us through successfully. Every school has the same testing calendar, but since SAA is a performing and visual arts charter school, we also have those activities on our calendar. Both areas take a lot of work!

Our second through fifth graders are working daily in computer lab honing their math skills through the Success Maker program and the fourth and fifth graders continue to work in IXL as well to improve their math. Kindergarten through third grade have added Raz-kids, an online reading program, to their schedule. The fourth through eighth graders are working diligently on their writing skills. We're counting on these supplements to the teacher instruction and assignments to support our students in reaching a level of proficiency in math and English language arts. (Even the themes of the kindergarten through fourth grade musicals relate to their math and language arts skills!) Please encourage your children to put forth their best effort to master the skills. Students should spend part of their homework time on these topics and should visit the FSA site to practice. Continue to read nightly and practice math facts.

The third through fifth graders will continue with their FAIR testing in reading this week. Please be on time daily as the testing starts first thing in the morning. We still have a few students who are late almost every day. It is especially important in grades K though 4th that students are on time because that is the reading block. It is so important that students become proficient in reading; it affects everything they study. Along the same line, please remember that Literacy Week is coming up and we hope you will participate. There is information on the weekly events attached to the information packet for this week.

Please remember to send in your enrollment information for next year. There have been a few changes to the parent/student contract which will be sent home shortly. We are certainly hoping all of our students will be returning!

Watch for information regarding the end-of-year trips for all of the classes. We have some great things planned and will be sending notices home soon. The middle schoolers will be sponsoring some fund raisers to help defray the cost of buses. We want everyone to be able to participate.
