I hope everyone has had an enjoyable mini-Principal's Corner vacation and is ready to finish out the year

Thank you to all of the parents who helped with painting sets and props for Bye Bye Birdie and to those who helped with "breakfast" for the FCAT-takers last week.

Monday and Tuesday the 3rd and 4th graders will be taking the Math FCAT in the morning. Fifth graders will take the Science FCAT at the same time. Then the 6th and 7th graders will take the Reading FCAT on the computer Tuesday and Wednesday. Only 5th and 8th graders are scheduled to test the last week (April 28 & 29). So far we have only two students who need to do make-up sessions. Thank you to the parents who had all of the students here on time last week!

Tuesday the kindergarten, first, and second grade classes will be on a field trip in the morning to see "Bears." Then the middle schoolers will go on a field trip Friday morning to see "The Sound of Music" presented by Sarasota High School theater students. Please return your permission slips if you haven't done so. Thursday, April 24, is "Take Your Son or Daughter to Work" Day. You were sent a letter from Superintendent of Schools Lori White regarding this. If you choose to participate, the student must bring the form on Friday signed by your supervisor in order to have an excused absence. Students will be expected to share what they observed with their classmates on Friday or the following Monday.

We are starting to plan for next year with some changes in the works, mostly at the middle school level. At the middle school level, we will be adding intensive math as well as advanced standing classes for students who qualify. We are also discussing extra enrichment classes for the middle school. A new elementary math series and a new middle school language arts program will be adopted. Look for a letter soon detailing these plans.
