Principal's Corner

It was wonderful to see the kindergarten through fourth graders perform traditional songs and dances. Even the eighth graders got into the spirit showing the dances they had learned. Almost all of the students participated in some way - the fifth graders and middle school students displayed their art and decorations and acted as servers of the delicious food sent in by parents. The evening turned into an open-mic session with spontaneous performances by Mr. Koci and Mr. Upholz on their guitars, first grade magicians, fifth grade singers, and an eighth grade comedian! I sent a separate email to parents in each grade level reminding everyone of the FCAT schedule. We start Wednesday morning promptly at 8:00 for all third through eighth graders with the exception of the 6B class. Because of the number of computers needed at the middle school level, 6B students will have their first test (math) on Thursday. Just in case you haven't seen the marquee at the neighboring public schools or didn't read the email, we are attaching another copy of the schedule to the printed version of this letter that will go home Monday. It is best for the students to do as few make-up tests as possible. Students seem to score higher when the test is taken within the regular testing group. I am sure teachers will continue to review, but at this point the things to remember are to get a good night's sleep, eat a good breakfast, and try your best.

Please remember that when waiting to turn onto Tree Lane in the afternoon, you cannot pull so far to the right on Fruitville Road that you are blocking the bicycle lane.
