- Minutes from the 11/13/2018 meeting unanimously approved with the addition of noting the "Motion to solicit bids to provide accounting services. Unanimously approved"
- Principals Report Unanimously approved
 - Enrollment starting in January online or in person
 - SAA is creating a marketing video about the school
 - Parent, staff and student survey has been distributed
 - 94 to 100% of the elementary parents agree with the safety provided and the teacher communication
 - Elimination of the sand and better physical facilities were the biggest areas for improvement
 - 85 to 100% of the middle school parents agree with the safety provided and the teacher communication
 - Need to improve the communication about SEL (Social Emotional Learning) especially within the middle school
- Financial Report Unanimously approved
 - Financials still contain a number of misclassified items due to the existing accounting firm
 - $_{\circ}$ The county administrative fee has just been reduced from 5% to 2%

- Financial Organizations
 - Reviewed proposals from Building Hope, Cavanaugh & Co, and SFS
 - Cavanaugh & Co proposal was an hourly rate, recommended by SSAS and Dan K.
 - SFS currently working with other local charter schools, very responsive, bills are sent to them for data entry. Additional fee of 1 1/2 % for payroll processing if desired. SAA is unable to write checks locally. The governing board would have online access to the financials.
 - Building Hope well known in the charter school industry, \$50/student this year increasing to \$100/student next year, fee includes payroll, data input would be handled by SAA, SAA can write checks locally, active in capital financing
- Motion to approve the administration's request to use Building Hope Unanimously approved
- Current Property Lease / Sale
 - Nothing has been finalized yet, currently negotiating
 - Any potential sale of the property would be after the passing of Dr. Rohr.
 - SAA capital outlay reimbursement requires a 5 year lease
- Purchase opportunity for new property
 - See the property financing summary document for details
 - Matt McHugh left the room for the remaining discussions
- Motion to disapprove the personal loan option presented to purchase the land -Unanimously approved
- Motion to simultaneously work on listing the existing unoccupied land property for sale, determine options for building on the existing unoccupied land, and new financing options for the new property Unanimously approved
- Governing board would like to wish the entire staff happy holidays and thank you for all the hard work and a successful first half of the school year
