Principal's Corner students and parents. We have seven full weeks of classes before the last week with graduation and end of year field trips. Be sure you have your calendars marked for all the upcoming events. Report cards were sent home last week to any student whose parent does not regularly use the parent portal. If you still need a copy, please call the office.

Tuesday, April 10 the book fair materials are being delivered. If you need volunteer hours, this is a chance to earn a couple after school to help set up the fair. It will run two days instead of one to give parents a chance to shop for summer reading books during the evening events. Volunteers are needed for set-up (4 - 6 PM), helping at the Fair during the day both Wednesday and Thursday, and breaking down the displays on Thursdaynight (6 - 7 PM). Also on Tuesday, the Governing Board will hold its April meeting at 8:10 AM in the administration building.

Tuesday is the first day of the FSA reading test for 3rd grade. The second part of the assessment is given on Wednesday. Please have your child get plenty of rest the night before and be on time in the mornings. Students are encouraged to eat a protein-rich breakfast at home but we will have yogurt and granola bars available for students in the classroom.

Wednesday the Book Fair will be open 8:00 AM - 6:00 PM. On Wednesday evening, we will serve hot dogs from 5:00 - 6:00 PM for parents and students attending the Internet Awareness workshop at 6:00 - 7:00 PM. Childcare is provided. We have a number of parents signed up but there is certainly room for more. **PLEASE RSVP!** Last week the Child Protection Team talked to the upper elementary and 6th graders about Internet safety and will continue with presentations to the seventh and eighth graders later this week. We hope you can join us Wednesday evening. We do need you to RSVP so we know how many teachers we need to stay with students and how much food to buy.

The Book Fair continues on Thursday from 8:00 AM - 6:00 PM. In the evening there will be a special presentation by the sixth graders of the musical "Dig It!" In sixth grade the social studies class focuses on world history with emphasis on ancient civilizations. Earlier this year the classes took a field trip to a local archaeological dig. Just a few weeks ago, the students presented their own plays on Egyptian culture. As a culmination, Mr Koci, Ms. Bergin, and Mrs. Julie have worked together on the musical as a way of infusing more art into the core class. The students will present their production at 6:00 PM on the Reading Garden stage. There is a sign -up sheet on the website for anyone wishing to come early (5:00 PM) for hot dogs.
